**Admiral Traffic Ramp**

A temporary ramp connection which has served city traffic for the past few years Thursday becomes a victim of paving progress on the Crosstown Expressway.

A spokesman for the Highway Department said Wednesday that paving work on the Crosstown will block the normal driving pattern of people using the Admiral Place connection to northbound traffic on the Mingo Valley Expressway.

**WORKMEN WILL START** removing the curb and gutter of the existing left turn bay for the eastbound traffic on Admiral Place that normally would turn north on the Mingo Valley freeway.

The work will be done in connection with paving of the Crosstown-Mingo Valley interchange.

**THE ADMIRAL PLACE** ramp connection has, for 5-6 years, served as a diamond interchange at the junction of Admiral Place and the Mingo Valley freeway.

When construction is finished on the Crosstown, the ultimate design will not allow traffic off

Admiral Place to go northbound to the Mingo Valley route. Neither will southbound traffic off the Mingo Valley freeway be able to go westbound on Admiral Place.
